#### Taken from Silsilah Ahadeeth as-Saheehah

1- 1432 – From Abdullaah ((ضي الله عي الله عن 1432 – From Abdullaah (ضي الله عن 1432 – a tent and he said:

'Would you be pleased to be one quarter of the people of Paradise?'

We said: 'Yes.'

said: ص الشعلي، س ل م) said:

#### 'Would you be pleased to be one third of the people of Paradise?'

We said: 'Yes.'

The Messenger (سلى الشعلي، سلم) said:

#### 'Would you be pleased to be one half of the people of Paradise?'

We said: 'Yes.'

said: ص الله عليه س لم) The Messenger

'I swear by Him in whose Hand is the soul of Muhammad; indeed I hope that you are half the people of Paradise, and that is because none except a Muslim soul will enter Paradise. And you people in relation to the amount of the people of Shirk are like a white hair on the skin of a black bull, or like a black hair on the skin of a red bull.' No. 849

2- 1433 – From Abdullaah bin 'Amr (ضربي الله عنه) who said: the Messenger of Allaah (خرب الشخلي، س لم) said:

'Do you know who the first group of people from my Ummah to enter Paradise will be?'

I said: 'Allaah and His Messenger know best.'

The Messenger (س الشعلي مس الم said:

'al-Muhajiroon; they will come on the Day of Judgment to the gate of Paradise, and request for it to be opened, then the gate keeper will say to them: 'Have you been taken to account for?'

They will say: 'What should we be taken to account for?! Indeed our swords were upon our shoulders in the path of Allaah until we died upon that.'

He will say: 'then it shall be opened for them, and they will take a nap in Paradise for forty years before the people enter it.' No. 853

3 – 1434 – From Aboo Bakrah (ضرب الله عنه), that the Prophet (ضرب الله عنه) said:

'If a person points weapon at his brother then they are both on the edge of Hell-Fire. And if he kills him, then they both will enter it together.'

[and in another Hadeeth of Aboo Bakrah: 'It was said: 'O Messenger of Allaah, this is the killer, but what about the victim?'

He (س لى الشرحلي الم said: **'Indeed he intended to kill his companion.'** No. 1231

4 – 1436 – from Jabir bin Abdullaah (حن ي الله عن) who said the Messenger of Allaah (حن ي الله عليه، س لم) said:

'When the people of Paradise enter Paradise, Allaah (عَزوجَل<sup>3</sup> will say to them: 'Is there anything else you desire that I may give you as extra?'

They will say: 'O our Lord, what can be greater than what you have given us?'

**Then Allaah will say: 'My Pleasure is greater.'** No. 1336

5 – 1437 – From al-'Irbaad bin Sareeyah (ضربي الله عنه) from the Prophet (من الله عنه) المراب المع الم

'If you ask of Allaah, then ask for al-Firdous, since indeed it is the centre of Paradise.' No. 2145

6 – 1439 – From the Prophet (ضربي الله عن ه) from the Prophet (خربي الله عن ه) المناطق المعالية المناطق المناطق

'The children of the Muslims will be upon a mountain in Paradise. They would be taken care of by Ibraaheem and Sara until they would be returned to their parents on the Day of Judgement.' No. 1467

7 – 1440 – From Aboo Maalik (خن ي الله عن) who said: 'The Prophet (خن ي الله عن) was asked طول السع لي الله علي الله عنه المعالي was asked about the children of the Mushrikeen and he said:

'They are the servants of the people of Paradise.' No. 1468

8 – 1442 – From Anas bin Maalik (خن ي الله عن) that he recited this Ayah: [**Verily, We have granted you Al-Kawthar (a river in Paradise)**]<sup>4</sup> and said the Messenger of Allaah (حرب الشرحلي، الشرحلي) said:

'I was given al-Kawthar, it is a river that flows, [like any river upon the face of the earth] and it does not branch off to other rivers. Its banks are tents made of Pearls. I touched its soil and it had a very strong fragrance of Musk, and its pebbles were pearls.' No. 2513
