Question: May Allaah grant you good, the questioner says: Is that which is done by some of the students of knowledge, by following the mistakes of some of the Duaat, and collecting them, and placing it on tapes; such that each Da'ee has a specific tape where his mistakes and lapses are mentioned? Is this methodology correct?

Shaykh Saalih al-Fawzaan (حفظه الله)¹: If the intent behind this is to clarify the truth, and clarify the mistakes; then this is good. This is calling to Allaah. We clarify the mistakes so the people do not fall into them.

As for if the intent is following desires and seeking revenge against a person, and to disparage the person; then this is not permissible, this is not permissible.
