Question: Is it permissible to travel from one place to another to commemorate the birthdays of pious people?

Answer: it is not permissible to hold a celebration to commemorate the birthday of the Messenger (لجريات الله غي س لم) or any other person, and certainly not to travel to attend such a commemoration.

His Eminence, Shaykh 'Abdul-'Azeez ibn 'Abdullah ibn Baaz has written in detail on this subject, stating that such an act is Bid'ah (innovation in religion) and was not done by the Messenger of Allaah ((من ي الله عن من)²), or any other scholars of the earliest and best three generations of Islam. Indeed, all goodness lies in following and imitating them.
